## Summary of Parish Council Meeting 2.26.19

The Parish Council was very pleased to see the new moveable wall fully installed. The total cost for this wall was \$27,192 and it has already been a great help to the Atrium class that meets in the basement.

They also had discussions about the Eagle River Institute and the Saint James House, which was be shared with the parish at the annual Church Family Meeting.

We also opened a discussion about the need to create a new employee position for the Church in the next year to ensure we have the ability to continue growing and managing well our Cathedral ministries and properties.

Finally, the amount of PFD tithe collected in 2018 was \$17,446, all which will go to fulfill our Parish commitment to help our School with extra financial support for four years.
